Location / Directions

Leaving the Autobahn (by car):

Arriving from the north (Hamburg / Rostock), leave the A111 and join the „Berliner Stadtring“ motorway (A100) in the direction of the „Zentrum“ (City centre), leave the urban motorway at the Spandauer Damm exit, pass Charlottenburg Palace and continue to the major Ernst-Reuter-Platz roundabout, second exit, straight ahead, pass the Memorial Church and on your right hand side you will find the Hotel Palace Berlin.

Arriving from east (Frankfurt / Oder) take the A12 as far as the Spreeau junction, continue on the A10 as far as the Nuthetal junction, and from there on the A115 in the direction of Berlin-Zehlendorf, follow the signs for the „Zentrum“ (city centre) as far as the Kurfürstendamm exit, drive along the Kurfürstendamm, in the direction Zentrum, turn left at the Café Kranzler and right at the next set of traffic lights, then bear right and follow the street, pass the Memorial Church and on your right hand side you will find the Hotel Palace Berlin.

Arriving from the south (Nürnberg / Hannover) take the A2 or A9 as far as the Werder junction, continue on the A10 as far as the Nuthetal junction, and from there on the A115 in the direction of Berlin-Zehlendorf, follow the signs for the „Zentrum“ (city centre) as far as the Kurfürstendamm exit, drive along the Kurfürstendamm, in the direction Zentrum, turn left at the Café Kranzler and right at the next set of traffic lights, then bear right and follow the street, pass the Memorial Church and on your right hand side you will find the Hotel Palace Berlin.

Arriving from the west (Hannover / Magdeburg) take the A2 as far as the Werder junction, continue on the A10 as far as the Nuthetal junction, and from there on the A115 in the direction of Berlin-Zehlendorf, follow the signs for the „Zentrum“ (city centre) as far as the Kurfürstendamm exit, drive along the Kurfürstendamm, in the direction Zentrum, turn left at the Café Kranzler and right at the next set of traffic lights, then bear right and follow the street, pass the Memorial Church and on your right hand side you will find the Hotel Palace Berlin.



From Berlin´s airports:

Tegel (9 km)

taxi: 20-30 minutes

bus: X9, 22 minutes, the bus stops Zoological Garden (10-minute service)

Tempelhof (6 km)

taxi: 20 minutes

underground: take underground U6 from „Platz der Luftbrücke“, direction „Alt Tegel“ and transfer at „Hallesches Tor“ to U1, direction „Krumme Lanke“ to „Wittenbergplatz“ short walk along the Tauentzienstrasse to the Europa Center

Schönefeld (25 km)

taxi: 45-60 minutes

S-Bahn (S9): 48 minutes (20 minutes service)

Airport-Express regional rail service (direction cities Nauen, Wittenberge, Stralsund) in 33 minutes (30-minute-service)

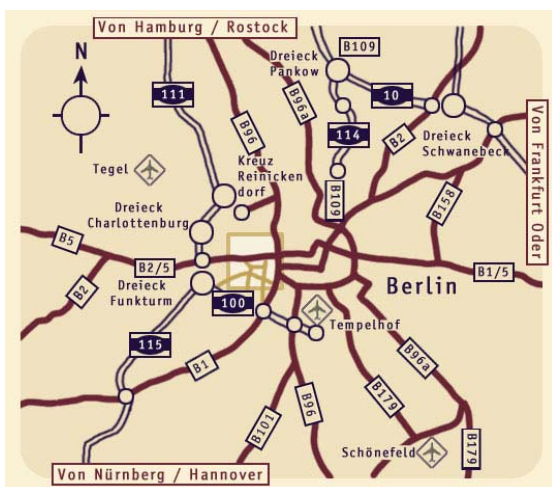
By rail:

Regional railway to Zoo railway station:

1 minute by taxi, 5 minutes to walk

Long-distance railway to Berlin main station:

8 minutes by taxi, with the city train three stations to Zoo railway station, afterwards 5 minutes to walk.





Environmental Zone Berlin:

We would like to inform you that from January 1, 2008, Berlin's inner city is designated as a "particle free emissions zone". Please be advised that when driving into this area of the city, a special approved label needs to be visibly displayed on all cars. The Hotel Palace Berlin is located inside the Environmental Zone.

The sticker costs from five to nine Euros. It is issued by the vehicle registration authority (Landesamt für Bürger und Ordnungsangelegenheiten/LABO, Internet: www.berlin.de/labokfz/dienststelle/index.html), by the exhaust gas test organisations such as TÜV, DEKRA, GTÜ and about 800 authorised garages in Berlin.

To get this sticker you need to bring vehicle registration certificate or the vehicle title alternatively the national car licence.
